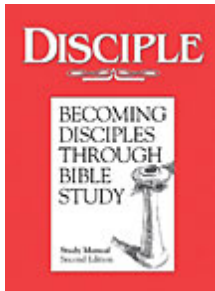

DISCIPLE is a program of disciplined Bible study aimed at developing strong Christian leaders.

The study gives the Old and New Testaments equal time, emphasizing the wholeness of the Bible as a revelation of God. DISCIPLE draws upon the work of scholars, the personal Bible reading and study of the participant, and dynamic group discussion to aid understanding of the Bible. The first study in the program is DISCIPLE: BECOMING DISCIPLES THROUGH BIBLE STUDY, a thirty-four week overview of the entire Bible.



Register now for Disciple I! Classes start Sunday, August 22 and continue on Sunday nights from 6 to 8:30 P.M., or Wednesday mornings beginning on Wednesday, August 25 from 9-11:30 A.M. You will study the entire Bible – the Old Testament in the 17 weeks prior to Christmas, and the New Testament after the first of the year.
